Early Childhood Screening



Screening is required by State Law before Kindergarten. That makes it sound as though a child should be screened right before kindergarten.

NOT SO!

Please call Lisa or Diane at 243-7543 during normal school hours to setup a screening.

Early Childhood Screening is a free check of:

- Height and Weight
- Vision and Hearing
- Immunization Records
- Developmental Assessment that include: communication, motor, cognitive and social-emotional skills

Scoring is based on the child's age at the time of screening, so being older does not give them an advantage.



Screening is most valuable for three-four year olds. If a child's developmental delays are not identified until they are about to enter kindergarten, they have missed out on one to two years of early childhood services that could make a huge difference to their school success!



If you are new to the district, if your child is 4, or if your child will be starting kindergarten within the next two years and has not been screened.....
